In reply to the request you forwarded to me from Robert Weiner inviting the Deputy Attorney General to serve as Co-Chair of the "Lawyers Have Heart" Race in 1995, I do not believe she should accept the invitation.

As Mr. Weiner noted, the Office of Personnel Management has previously approved participation by government employees in this race under an exception to the regulations that generally prohibit fundraising in the federal workplace other than for the Combined Federal Campaign. I am sure that he is correct that OPM also will grant an exception for the race in 1995.

However, as noted by the Deputy Director of OPM in her approval letter, employees must also conform to the government-wide standards of conduct when participating in a fundraising event. There is some confusion regarding the application of these rules, but it is clear that the OPM approval does not waive the standards of conduct restricting official participation in fundraising events. More specifically, it does not waive the provision prohibiting solicitation of subordinates and of persons having business with the employee's agency or the one prohibiting the use of one's official position to further the fundraising effort.

The fact that the Deputy's name and title would be used on fundraising material and that she would be asked to promote the race among Justice Department attorneys indicates that there would be an improper use of her position were she to serve as Co-Chair of the race. Of course, the Deputy would be free to run in the race along with other federal employees if she wishes to do so.

As Co-Chair of the Fifth Annual Lawyers Have Heart 10K Race and Walk to benefit the D.C. Chapter of the American Heart Association, I'm writing to ask that Jamie Gorelick serve as a Co-Chair of the Race in 1995.

Lawyers Have Heart is one of the largest events by the Washington legal community to benefit a charitable organization. The Race has received approval from the Office of Personnel Management for each of the last four years to allow government lawyers to participate in the fundraising efforts and we expect to be approved again. I include a copy of the approval from last year.

The Race raised nearly \$180,000 for the American Heart Association last year. Nearly 2,500 runners and walkers participated in the events.

We have had a government Co-Chair for prior races. Last year, Jean Hanson, then General Counsel of the Treasury Department, served as Co-Chair. Alan Raul, General Counsel of the Agriculture Department, was one of the founders of the race. Because the Race is a project of the Washington legal community, it would be most appropriate to have a Co-Chair from the Justice Department.

Dear Ms. Hanson:

This is in response to your letter in which you sought the approval of the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) for you and other government officials to organize "Lawyers Have Heart," a fundraising event to benefit the American Heart Association. You note that OPM has approved your request for the past three years.

Approval by OPM is necessary as this type of fundraising by government officials is subject to the constraints imposed by our regulations and appropriate executive orders concerning the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC). The CFC is the only authorized fundraising in the Federal workplace. However, the Director of OPM may authorize exceptions to that annual solicitation. The former Director of OPM granted your request in the past with the understanding that the event, to be held during the month of May, not interfere with or overlap the CFC. I am granting approval for the June 1994 event with the same caveat.

As you know, that new regulations issued by the Office of Government Ethics (Federal Register, Vol. 57, No. 153, August 7, 1992) specifically reference fundraising activities. I request that you discuss the "Lawyers Have Heart" event with your agency ethics official and obtain written approval so that you are fully in conformance with these regulations.
