On November 17, 1944 a body already in the status of decomposition was found in a remote Beet field of the estate Obergrashof the urban community Dachau. At the autopsy by the safety police of this place it was found out that the dead probably concerns a downed American flier. During the air raid against Dachau on July 31, 1944 an enemy bomber was shot down in the vicinity of the above mentioned estate, and was salvaged by the airbase Schleissheim. At that time several dead enemy fliers were found in the shot-down aircraft. On September 8, 1944 not far from that place of crash a dead flier was found in a field. The dead belonged to that crew. At that time the finding of the body was reported to the airbase Schleissheim and the dead was taken to there. For this reason the airbase Schleissheim was notified also and it was promised from there that the dead would be taken away. However after the body has not been taken away until November 23, 1944 the airbase Schleissheim was called once more, and the safety police of this place was notified that the body would not be taken away. For this reason this body had to be recovered by the safety police Dachau and was buried November 28, 1944 on the new Cemetery at this place;

The dead was already heavily decomposed, so it can be assumed that the man died July 31, 1944. The head and one hand were lying apart from the body and one arm was missing completely. The uniform was preserved somewhat and it was a light-brown Flying suit with harnesses at the shoulders and between the legs. Besides this there were Flying boots (large) with rubber soles. There was no parachute, however. The body could be handled only with rubber gloves. At the recovery of the dead the above mentioned items could be secured. At first all of them were dried to lose the smelling and to be made ready for shipment at all. It is beyond doubt that this case concerns a flier with the name: Russell George BLAKELEY. (Pencil note: Age 20 - 25 years).

For the purpose of further instigation (Report to the Red Cross etc.) and for Evaluation the items are attached hereto.

It is remarked that there were ~~AMER~~ expenses of about 90.00 RM for the burial of this soldier in the urban community Dachau. Refunding of these expenses is requested.

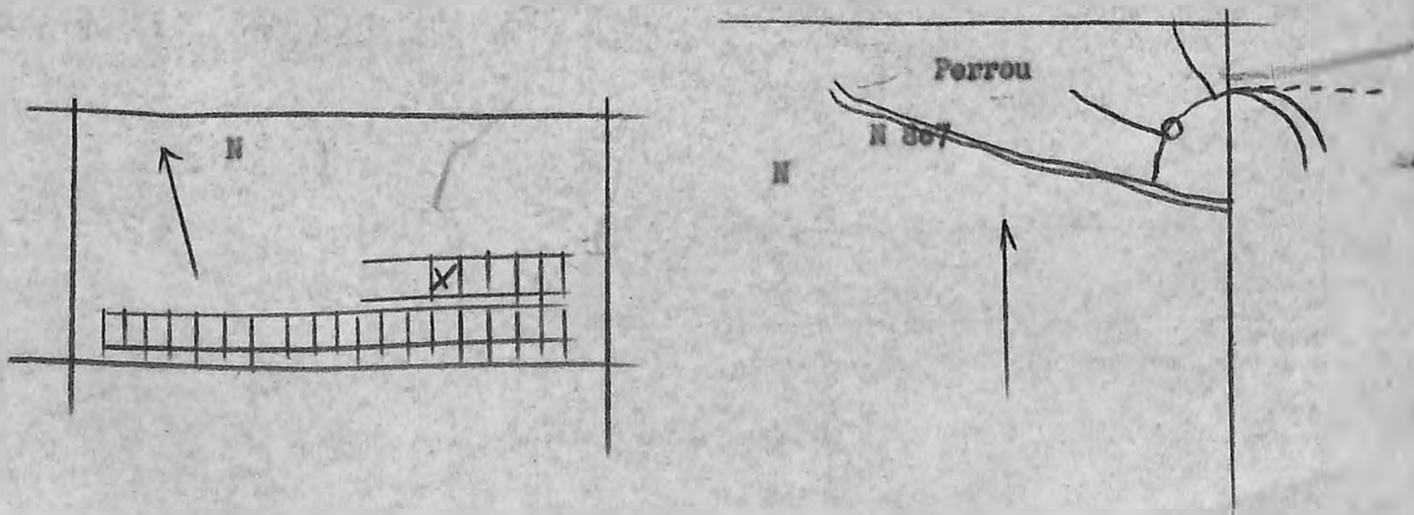

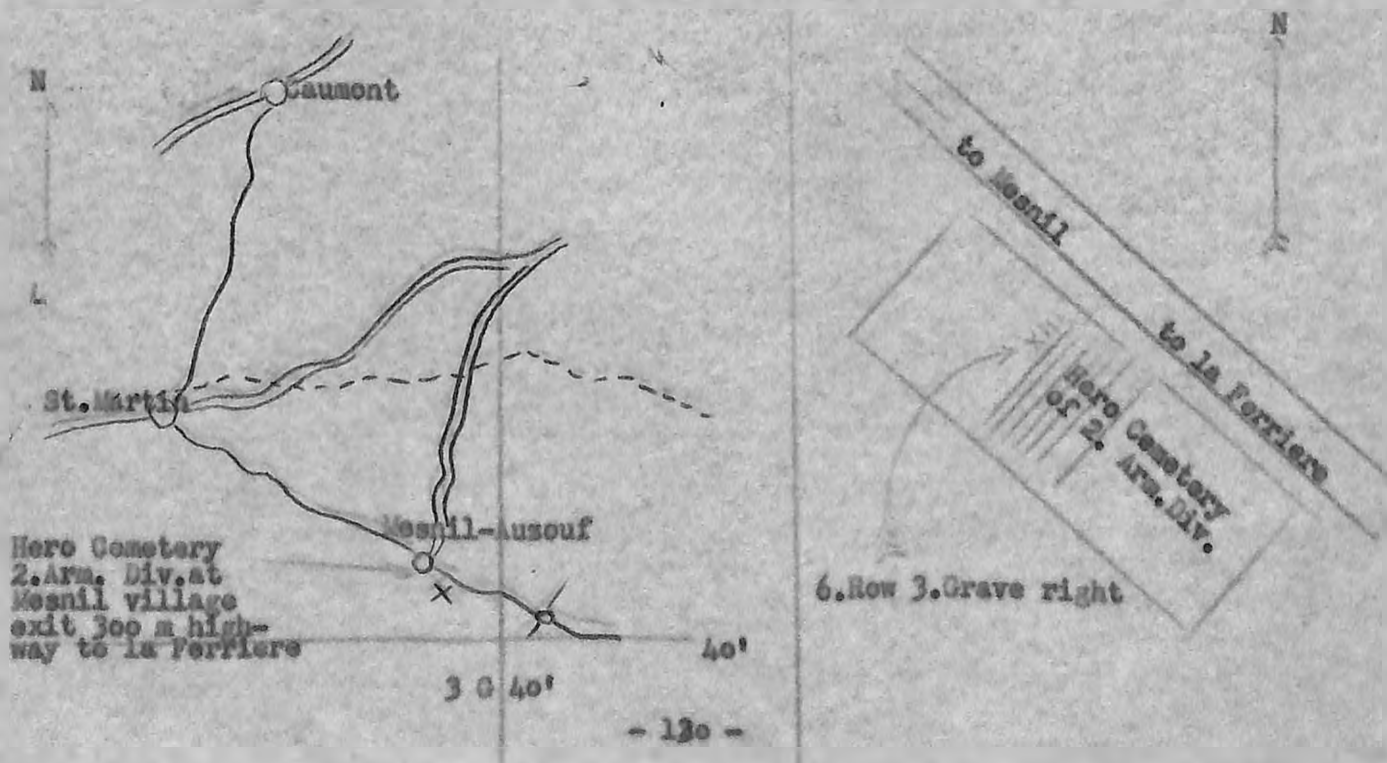

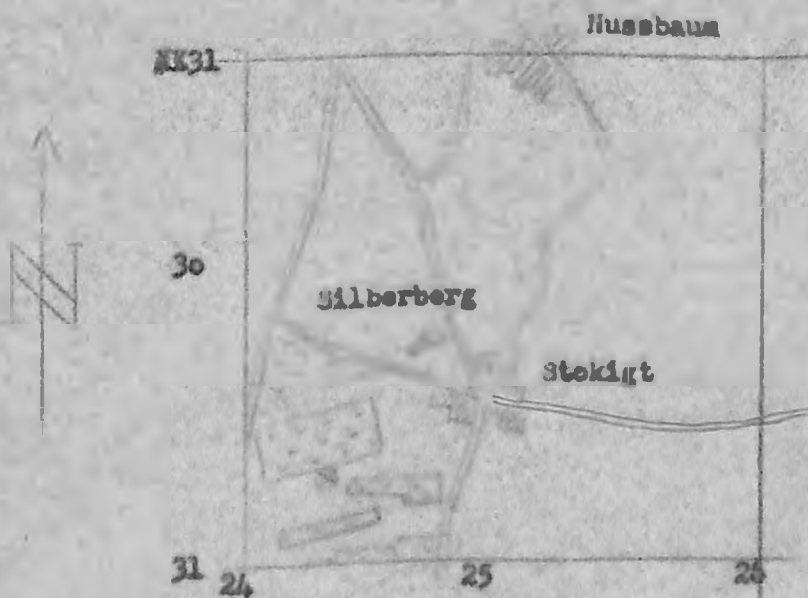

On 17 Dec. 1944 at about 12 30 an enemy airplane of the type "Fortress" was shot down at Wilmesau district of Bielitz/Oberschlesien . The crew bailed out by parachute .One man of the crew being captured

A.J. E L L I N

was shot by the police Sgt. Swittaj at the attempt to escape. According to statement of physician the death was afflicted by bullet through abdomen. No papers or other documents for identification were found. An identification tag was missed ,too. Solely a bracelet with the inscription A.J. Ellin No. 15364395 was found. This bracelet was forwarded with the documents of the remaining 8 prisoners to Information Center West Oberursel on 17 Dec. 1944.

Ellin was buried at the cemetery of Jawischowitz district of Bielitz - grave location immediately between the mortuary (tool booth) and hedge - on 20 Dec. 1944 at 1700 . 1 polish grave digger and the police master (police post Jawischowitz) attended the burial.

According to his features E. had a Jewish appearance. No pictures of the grave were taken.

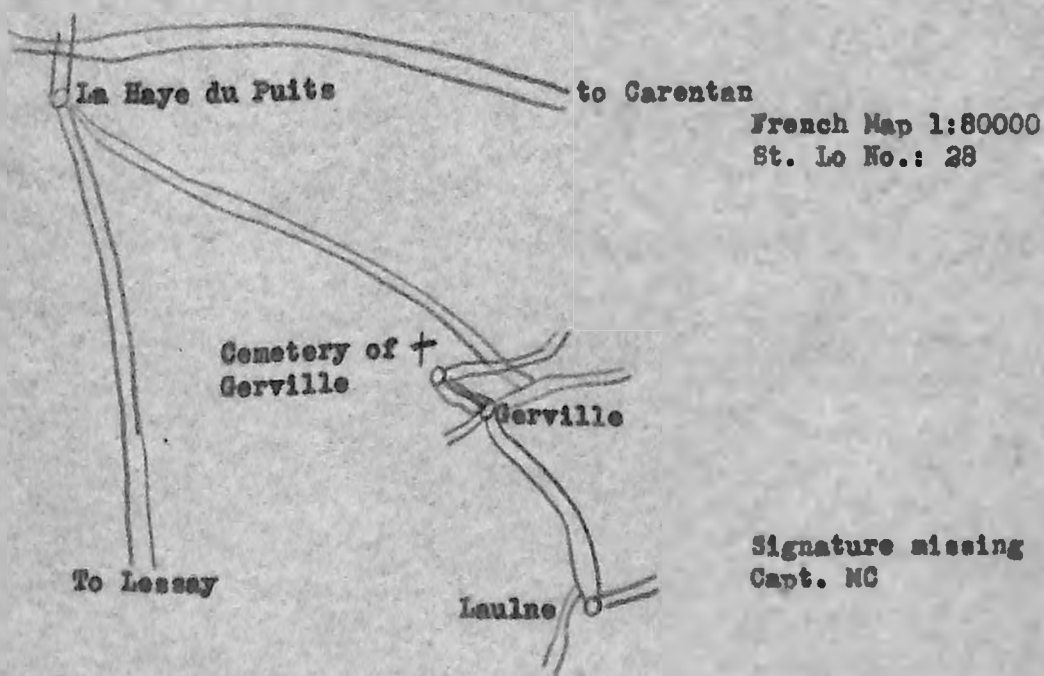

Drawing of Grave Location

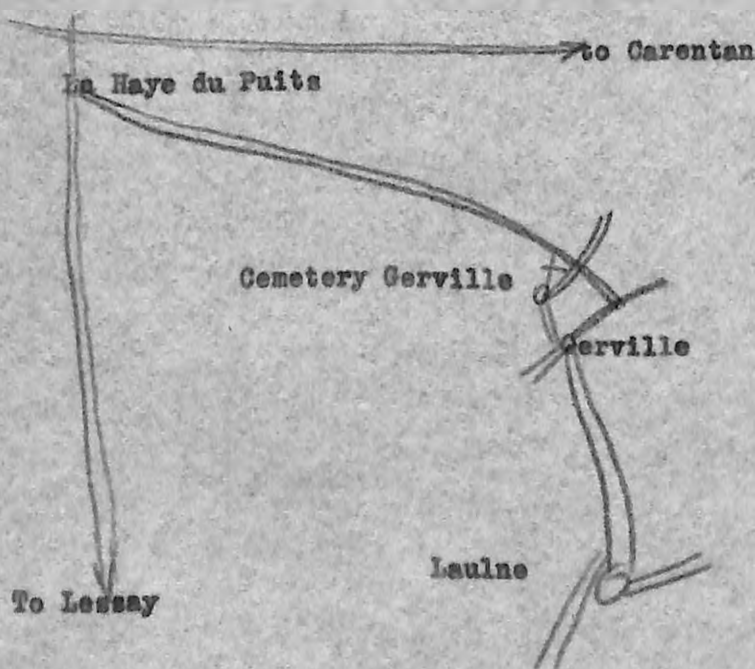

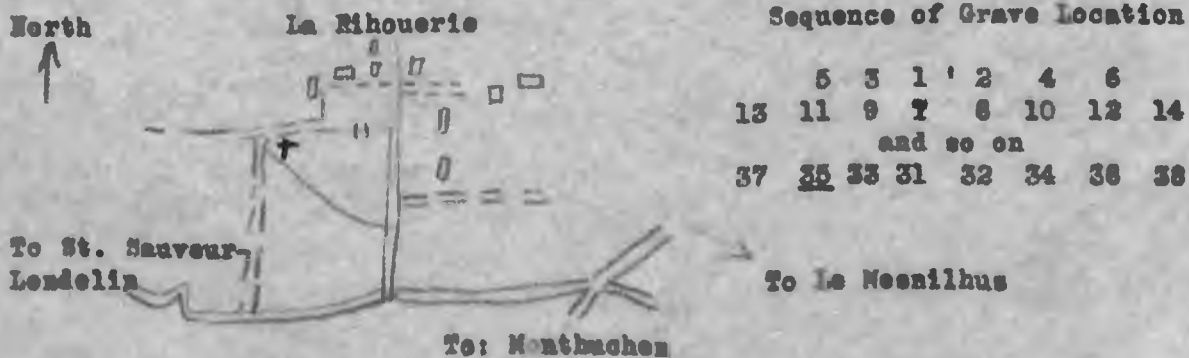

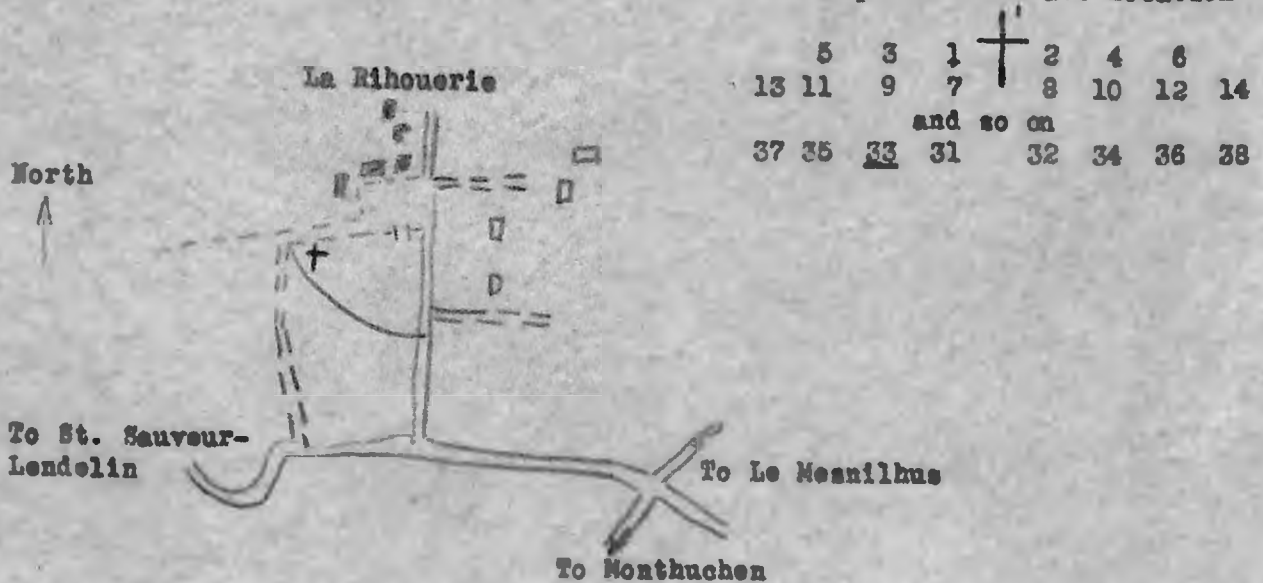
