DESCRIPTION

The Stroud House is a one-and-one-half-story frame cottage facing eastward toward the City Hall, directly across Third Street. The cottage is an exceptionally graceful remodeling of an 1890 Eastlake design into a Colonial Revival cottage. The main facade is dominated by a generous one-story porch, the cornice of which forms a wide low arch springing from two Tuscan columns. The porch cornice continues a short span to the corner where it is received by a trio of slender Tuscan columns rising from a masonry pier. A wood balustrade surrounds the porch. A central doorway is flanked by large double-hung windows. A clipped gable rises over the porch roof and is centered by four slender windows divided by delicate muntins. The remodeling has produced a secondary entrance on the north facade and an enclosed sunporch at the south side rear.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: C Area of significance: architecture

The Stroud House was redesigned by architect A.O. Clark for a leading merchant of the city, A.B. Stroud, and as such is an excellent example of adapting early-twentieth-century styles to a structure which was built earlier.
