Although its exact date of construction is unknown, the two-story brick structure at 10410 Stanley is probably the most unusual of all the nineteenth century architectural resources examined in Genesee County. Its most interesting feature is its massing which can best be described as two gable-roofed rectangular sections linked at the sides by their cornicelines. The four steeply pitched gable ends and the three similar gable dormers feature very elaborate and lacy vergeboards which contribute to the building's Gothic appearance. Other special characteristics of the home include segmented brick arches over symmetrically placed windows and a decorative brick bond consisting of six stretcher rows placed between single rows of headers.

The two-story frame structure on Linden Road exhibits the irregular massing typical of Queen Anne styles. This fact would seem to support its current owner's assertion that the home was constructed in 1878. The building's ornamentation, however, is decidedly Gothic in character. The open wrap-around porch, for example, features delicately turned posts with brackets, numerous pendants, and vergeboards resembling icicles. Each of the residence's many gable ends is also highlighted with lacy vergeboards.

Though its exact date of construction is unknown, the two-story brick structure at 4344 Frances is Italianate in styling and displays a square floorplan, boxed massing, and a small projecting bay to one side. Its front facade exhibits a one bay entrance porch detailed with turned and bracketed uprights. The rounded arch windows, most of which occur in pairs, create a balanced fenestration; each features a stone lug sill and a double brick arched lintel. The structure features corbeling at its cornicelines and a truncated hip roof.
